From the Director

I hope that by the time you receive this bulletin the summer weather has improved. Regardless of the weather, our library and the other libraries in our RCLS area of service had the highest circulation of library materials since the System began 50 years ago. We hope the trend continues as more of our residents explore and experience our many resources and services.

Our Board of Trustees has approved the purchase of a CD/DVD security tower. This is similar to a vending machine. These items will be checked out to you first, and then dispensed. Like other libraries, we have experienced theft of popular movies, games, and music. We plan to have the unit installed during the fall.

After you check out materials, either at our express station or with a staff member, the security tags sometimes set off the alarm as you leave the building. If this happens, please return to

the Circulation Desk so that staff can correct the problem. Staff does have the right to inspect the material and any packages you might have. Please cooperate with us to ensure that our materials are safe.

Thanks to a NYS Library Construction Grant, we have replaced the Village Library Branch walkway and made repairs to the ramp. If you have not been to the branch, try to visit. The building's interior was renovated two years ago.

I will be celebrating my 15th anniversary as Library Director on September 12. The time has just flown by for me. I consider myself to be very fortunate. I have a terrific Board of Trustees, a great staff and a wonderful, supportive community that uses the library, understands its importance, and supports the library through local tax dollars.

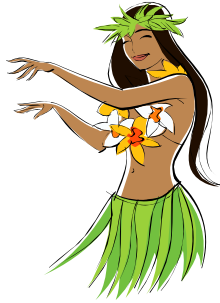

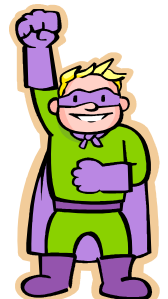

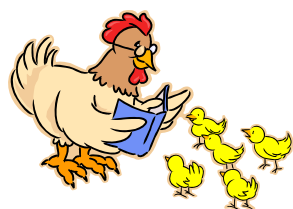
